Procedure: Endoscope passed to 2nd portion of duodenum without problems. Esophagus, stomach and proximal duodenum visualized. Retroflexion of scope done in stomach and cardia visualized as well.

Esophagus: GEJ at 38 cm; SCJ at 38 cm.

Stomach:

Antrum: **Erythema**

Pylorus: normal

Body: **Erythema** and small nodular possible polyp

Fundus/cardia: **Erythema**

Bulb: normal

Duodenum: Descending duodenum: normal

Patient tolerated procedure well

Biopsies taken: done

Location: Antrum and Body

Estimated Blood Loss: none

Complications: none

Recommendations: PPIs simple dose for weeks and waiting for the result of pathology in the next 10 days
