



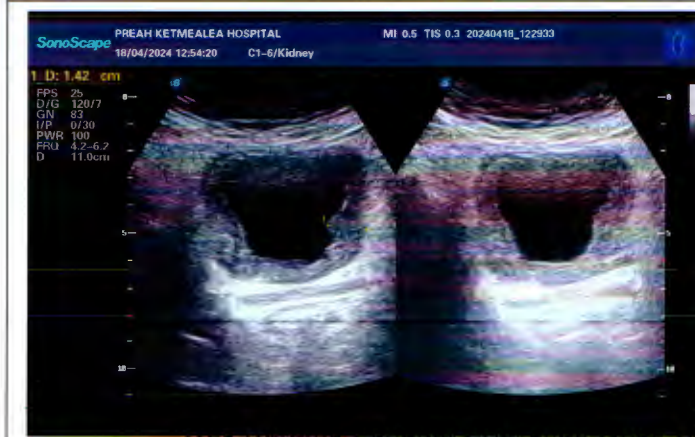
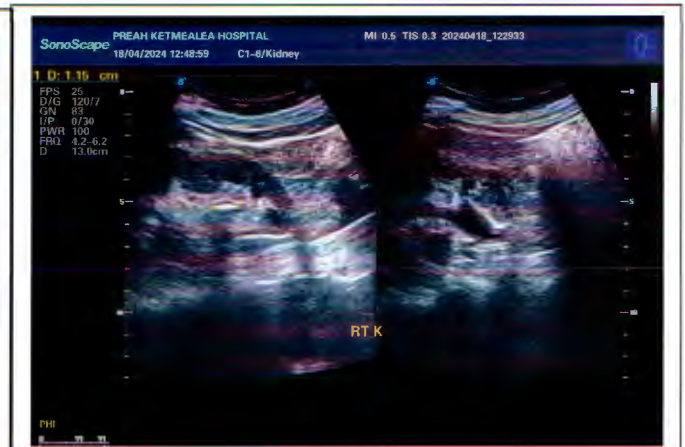
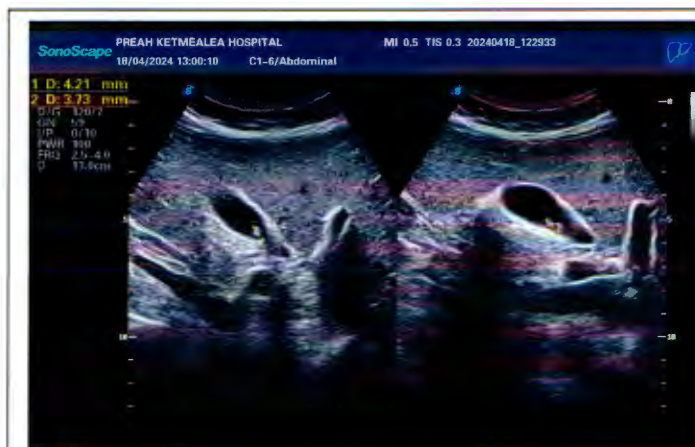

ULTRASOUND ABDOMINAL AND PELVIC

- **Liver:** Normal in size, regular contours, homogeneous echo structure. There is no evidence of a lesion within the liver parenchyma. The portal vein and hepatic veins are not dilated.
- **GB:** Normal in size, with a thin wall. evidence of gallstones 3mm to 6mm.
- **Biliary tract:** Not dilated.
- **Pancreas:** Normal in shape with a homogeneous echo structure. The pancreatic duct is not dilated.
- **Spleen:** Normal in size and homogenous echo-structure.
- **Right kidney:** Normal in size, well-differentiated cortical pelvis zone. evidence of kidney stone measure 11mm intra calyx.
- **Left kidney:** Normal in size, well-differentiated cortical pelvis zone. No evidence of kidney stone.
- **Urinary bladder:** Moderately distended, with a thick irregular wall measure 14mm without evidence of bladder stone.
- **Uterus:** Anteverted position, DAP: 34 mm
Myometrium: homogenous echo-structure, No mass or nodule visible.
 - No evidence of adenomegaly intra-abdominal. The pouch of Douglas is free of fluid.

CONCLUSION:

- Right renal stone.
- A few cholelithiasis.
- Chronic cystitis.
