

HEAD CT-SCAN REPORT

CLINICAL DETAILS: HTN and diabetes, stroke?

TECHNIQUE: Helical acquisition CT of head without contrast.

FINDING:

Sequels ischemic stroke at the right para ventricle and temporal lobe.

No established major vessel vascular territory acute infarct.

No intra or extra axial hemorrhage or collection.

No hydrocephalus.

No brain herniation.

No displaced midline structure.

Opacification of the left maxillary sinus containing calcifications suggestive of fungal sinusitis.

The air cells of the petrous temporal bone are non-opacified.

No evidence of orbital mass.

No bone aggressive lesion or fracture.

IMPRESSION :

Sequels ischemic stroke at the right para ventricle and temporal lobe.

No established major vessel vascular territory acute infarct.

No intra or extra axial hemorrhage or collection.

Chronic fungal sinusitis of the left maxillary sinus.
